Touring Entry Saturday and/or Sunday NO SUVs, Trucks or Vans

- Registered race cars are FREE but the driver and passenger must have signed a VSCDA waiver and be wearing a VSCDA wrist band. This is not a race. All rules must be followed!
- All persons driving street cars must sign a VSCDA Waiver, complete entry form, pay fee and get a touring wrist band.
- <u>All passengers must sign a VSCDA waiver and get a touring wrist band;</u> Parents must sign for minor children.
- Only the person wearing the Driver's wrist band may drive. No one will be allowed out on the track without a touring wrist band.
- After registration, all street cars must proceed to the touring paddock for a safety check & sticker at least 1 hour prior to the touring session.
- Touring Drivers Meeting is MANDATORY!

Touring Instructions

Drive the Road America racecourse in your vintage or modern car in company with similar vehicles (NO SUVs, Trucks or Vans). 1 passenger is allowed. Registration must be completed at least 1 hour prior to the Touring session. All street cars must proceed to the touring paddock for the mandatory drivers meeting and to receive your touring sticker. Seat belts and a valid U.S. issued driver's license are required. See the event schedule & listen for announcements for <u>exact</u> times. The pace car and starter will be used to control touring sessions. You may not pass the pace car unless waved or pointed by the driver. Top speed is 55 M.P.H. No passing is allowed except on the straights and, ONLY if the driver being overtaken indicates on which side they wish to be passed on.

Passengers in Touring Cars - No child may be held as a "babe in arms" nor be allowed to ride in a removable child's car seat during touring. The child must be large enough to see over the dashboard or out the side of the touring car and be safely secured by the touring car's seat belts (or competition harness if in a race car). If a child is to tour in a racecar, all

of the above must be met and, in addition, the child should be wearing ear protection; for open race cars a proper fitting,

full-face shield helmet. Exchanging passengers is only allowed in pit lane; stay to the extreme right.

Registration – All touring entrants must register at VSCDA registration. (Gate 6) You must complete the entry form, sign the VSCDA waiver and pay the fee. If you have pre-registered you must still sign the waiver and get your wristband. Racecars registered for Elkhart Lake Vintage Festival XXX[®] are **FREE but the driver and passenger must have signed**

a VSCDA waiver and be wearing a VSCDA wrist band.

Touring Instructions – Listen for the track announcer regarding staging/grid prior to the touring sessions. Touring sessions will stage south of the VIP Tower, before Turn 1. Attend the **Mandatory Touring Driver's Meeting in the Touring Paddock**. <u>See the schedule for time</u>. Touring cars will enter the racetrack upon instructions from the Chief Steward and will exit the track at the same location. Touring ends when the checkered flag is displayed at the bridge. All cars will then proceed at a MUCH reduced speed, in single file to exit.

Guidelines for Touring Safety

VSCDA is not responsible for the mechanical or electrical condition of your vehicle. By signing the entry form you acknowledge that it is 100% your responsibility that your vehicle is capable of operating safely at normal interstate highway speeds. We recommend you check the following:

At a minimum the following items should be attended to prior to participating in a touring session:

- 1. Hub caps must be removed
- 2. Lug nuts must be tight
- 3. Brake lights must be operational
- 4. Brake fluid levels should be adequate

- Engine, hoses and seat belts inspected
- 6. Soft tops totally secured (up or down)
- 7. All body panels secured
- 8. Do not over fill gas tank

Check out the local shops and restaurants in our downtown area. A non-judged car show follows on Lake Street. Thank you for joining us and enjoy your visit in Elkhart Lake!

Instructions

YOU MUST HAVE GONE THROUGH VSCDA REGISTRATION, AT GATE 6 ROAD AMERICA, SIGNED THE PROPER WAIVERS, AND DISPLAY THE CLING DECAL ON YOUR WINDSHIELD!!! THE DECAL IS WHAT ALL WORKERS AND LAW ENFORCEMENT WILL BE LOOKING FOR ON YOUR CAR TO ALLOW YOU PROPER ACCESS ON THE TOUR!

- 1. Staging will begin INSIDE Gate 5 at 1:30 p.m. Please form lines as directed by tour officials (in traffic vests) Racecars led by a Featured Marque car will stage on the pavement and leave first). Then the remaining streetcars will follow.
- 2. When you arrive in downtown Elkhart Lake, there will be Tour Officials that will direct you where to park along Lake Street. There will be a police escort back to Road America for the racecars at 4:30 pm. Racecars leaving without police escort will forfeit their racing privileges for the weekend. All other cars must be re-parked at 4:30 if you plan stay in town. Parking tickets will be issued if you don't park correctly.
- 3. This IS NOT a race, rules of the road must be obeyed, NO passing allowed. You will not be required to stop for stop signs where police wave you thru. Drivers are not allowed to "drop back" and race forward on any part of the circuit. Stay close to the car in front of you to keep the tour together.
- 4. Drive safely and have fun!

- 2:45 p.m. Police escorted tour will commence from Road America.
- 4:25 p.m. Racecar participants return to your vehicle to prepare for police escorted departure. Police escort departs downtown for Road America.

Gather on the Green Concours d'Elegance – Saturday 4 PM

Gather on the Green is an informal concours event held on the lawn of the Osthoff Resort and Conference Center. The purpose of the show is to raise money for Camp Anokijig, which is a long established summer camp for kids in the area and to provide an exciting array of show cars for the enjoyment of racers and spectators. It takes place AFTER the Road Course Re-enactment and Lake Street car show. It is within walking distance.

We have a number of spots blocked off for Aero Warrior cars that would like to participate. The show is for "better quality" show cars. Also, cars with racing history, special pedigree or interesting survivors are also welcome to participate. It is your decision to enter. If you decide not to be part of the lawn show, your car will stay on Lake Street which is adjacent to the venue.

The cost to participate is a minimum \$10 donation. Spectators are free, and can purchase tickets for \$1 to vote for the car of their choice. 100% of the proceeds are given to Camp Anokijig. Voting closes at 6:30 and trophies awarded at 6:35, winners announced at the band stand. It is a very fun show.

Entrants will receive an acceptance letter. Volunteers will direct you to a parking place on the lawn.

VSCDA / Elkhart Lake Vintage Festival Saturday Evening Dinner at the Osthoff: After the show, step inside the Osthoff and enjoy dinner and an evening with Porsche racing legend Vic Elford. This will be the official Aero Warrior dinner.

Mr. Elford was the outright winner of the 1971 12 hours of Sebring in a Porsche 917 and raced everything under the sun from Trans-Am Camaros to NASCAR stock cars.

Dinner starts at 7:30 following the show.
